Our free vegetable give a way is on Friday evenings at the garden between 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. We delivered vegetables to homebounds. On July 28<sup>th</sup> we will have a program at the school Cafetorium to honor the participants of Camp Connect. Everyone is invited. The Sunflower Festival is on Saturday, August 19<sup>th</sup>, between the hours of 10:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. I am still working on getting the rides, and the Beer Garden.

#### **MUNICIPAL MANAGER'S COMMENTS**

Municipal Manager Markus stated our contractor for our third local street levy project is well underway. They have made all of their saw cuts and they are pushing at the low end of Lawson down by Church Street so they could actually be finished by tomorrow or no later than Thursday morning. We advertised last Tuesday and we advertised today and we will have our bid opening on the 27<sup>th</sup>. That will tell us who our asphalt contractor is going to be. Actually you can get your asphalt down two weeks after your last concrete pour, but we prefer to do 30 days. In any event it will be at the convenience of whoever the successful bidder is and they will have until the end of October to get the work complete but I am sure they will have it completed before then.

We have rebuilt some catch basins and added an additional one once we got the area exposed so that should be a real nice addition for the project. That is all I have.
